
A Biblical Prescription for Family Gatherings:




1. Trust God no matter what the circumstances

Then they made signs to his father, to find out what he would like to name the child. He asked for a writing tablet, and to everyone's astonishment he wrote, "His name is John."


Immediately his mouth was opened and his tongue was loosed and he began to speak, praising God. The neighbors were all filled with awe...


